Dear Member:

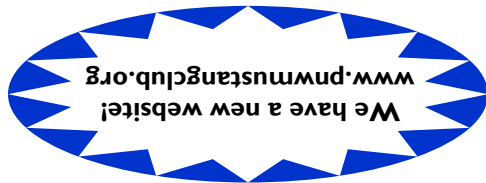
